# **POINTS OF OBSERVATION(PART2)** from (John 4). Observe closely what He said to the woman, regarding salvation.

<sup>10</sup> Jesus answered and said to her, "**If you knew the gift of God, and who it is who says to you, 'Give Me a drink,' you would have asked Him, and He would have given you living water."** John 4:10

Whoever drinks of this water will thirst again, <sup>14</sup> but whoever drinks of the water that I shall give him will never thirst. But the water that I shall give him will become in him a fountain of water springing up into everlasting life." John 4:13-14

### <sup>25</sup> The woman said to Him, "I know that Messiah is coming" (who is called Christ). "When He comes, He will tell us all things." <sup>26</sup> Jesus said to her, "I who speak to you John 4:25-26 am He."

<sup>27</sup> And at this point His disciples came, and they marveled that He talked with a woman; yet no one said, "What do You seek?" or, "Why are You talking with her? The woman then left her waterpot, went her way into the city, and said to the men, <sup>29</sup> "Come, see a Man who told me all things that I ever did. Could this be the Christ?" <sup>30</sup> Then they went out of the city and came to Him John 4:27-30

<sup>31</sup> In the meantime His disciples urged Him, saying, "Rabbi, eat." <sup>32</sup> But He said to them, "I have food to eat of which you do not know." <sup>33</sup> Therefore the disciples said to one another, "Has anyone brought Him anything to eat?" John 4:31-33

<sup>34</sup> Jesus said to them, "My food is to do the will of Him who sent Me, and to finish His work. <sup>35</sup> Do you not say, 'There are still four months and then comes the harvest'? Behold, I say to you, lift up your eyes and look at the fields, for they are already white for harvest! John 4:34-35

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<sup>38</sup> I sent you to reap that for which you have not labored; others have labored, and you have entered into their labors."

#### SALVATION/POSITION/PRIEST

#### DISCIPLESHIP/CONDITION/AMBASSADOR

Every believer measures up to the full demands of God's righteousness in Christ (2 Cor. 5:21).

Salvation involves one's <u>standing</u> in Christ (one's perfect position in Him).

With salvation the emphasis is upon what God has done (1 Cor. 15:3-4).

The focus of salvation is upon the <u>work of</u> <u>Christ (1 Cor. 1:18).</u>

Salvation is God's commitment to His Word based on the work of His Son (Rom. 3:24).

The saved person is a saint (1 Cor. 1:2), a position shared equally by all believers.

Believers often do not measure up to the full demands of discipleship (Luke 14:25-33).

Discipleship involves one's <u>state</u> (one's actual practice or condition).

With discipleship the emphasis is upon what man must do (Luke 14:25-33).

The focus of discipleship is upon <u>the Word</u> <u>of Christ</u>, His teaching (John 8:31).

Discipleship is the believer's commitment to Christ's Word based on his relationship to Christ (John 6:68).

The disciple is a student (Matt. 11:29). Some believers are better students than others.

AS A BELIEVER-PRIEST YOUR PRIMARY FOCUS IS VERTICAL (RELATIONSHIP)	AS AMBASSADOR YOUR PRIMARY FOCUS IS HORIZONTAL (RELATIONSHIP)
Salvation is belief in Christ (1 John 3:23a; John 3:36).	Discipleship requires obedience to all of Christ's commands (Matthew 28:19-20).
Salvation is the believer hearing His Word and believing on Him (John 5:24).	Discipleship is the believer sitting at His feet and hearing His Word (Luke 10:39).
The believer is never instructed to obey the demands of discipleship in order to be saved. This would be salvation by works (LS)	The believer seeks to fulfill all the demands of discipleship because he is saved. This is being saved "unto good works" (Eph. 2:10).
Salvation involves a faith in Christ (John 3:16, 6:40,47).	Discipleship involves doing not just hearing the Word (James 1:22).

SALVATION/POSITION/PRIEST SALVATION	DISCIPLESHIP/CONDITION/AMBASSADOR
God's salvation is perfect, lacking nothing (Col. 2:10; 1 Cor. 1:30).	Measuring up in discipleship is less than perfect, but "I press on" (Phil. 3:12-13).
To be saved a person must believe on Jesus Christ (John 3:16; Acts 16:31). The belief in the Lord Jesus Chris is a one time moment of faith never to be repeated and never to be lost.	To be a disciple a person must continue in Christ's Word, love Christ supremely, deny self, forsake all that he possesses, bear his cross daily, etc. The requirements of discipleship are many and they are difficult.
Discipleship (and all that it involves) is not a requirement for salvation.	Discipleship is a priviledge of every saved person.

Salvation involves receiving <u>God's gift (</u> John 1:12; Eph. 2:8-9).	Discipleship involves receiving <u>God's</u> <u>instruction</u> (Acts 2:42).
