POINTS OF OBSERVATION

TO EXPERIENCE RESURRECTION POWER/P2 SALVATION

1. The word abide means to remain, stay, reside, dwell
2. Abide for the believer means to obey his words/commands 1Jn3:24
3. **Salvation** requires us to **believe in Jesus** as Savior Jn.4:42
4. **Discipleship** requires us to **obey Jesus** as Lord Lk. 6:46
5. When someone say's "**Jesus is my Lord and Savior,**" what that should mean is "**I'm saved by faith,** and **I'm a disciple by volition/choice.**"
6. **IT'S POSSIBLE TO KNOW GOD IN THE SALVATION SENSE BUT NOT INTIMATELY EVEN AFTER 3 YEARS** as seen with philip who was a disciple.(JN 14:9)
7. **Violate any of these and you grieve GHS, thus nullifying the resurrection power that could have been yours to live out the spiritual life.**

The subject of Discipleship is frequently discussed today. Men are called to become disciples without any definition of the concept, and without any clarification of the requirements the Lord makes of those who are His disciples.

Discipleship is frequently equated with salvation and often erroneously made a condition for becoming a Christian. Thus many are confused about their relationship to Jesus Christ.

POINTS OF OBSERVATION

1. Relationship and Fellowship with God are to be distinguished
2. Relationship relates to our POSITION in Christ.
3. FELLOWSHIP relates to our EXPERIENCE with Christ
4. Our relationship with Christ is not visible to the eye
5. Our Fellowship/Discipleship should be visible to the eye Jn. 13:34-35
6. 1 John 1:9 must be a SOP for the believer to sustain fellowship with God
- 7A. Violate any of these and you grieve GHS, which prevents you from walking by means of the Spirit, resulting in no power to live the spiritual life.
- 7B. Believer will be operating from the energy of the flesh/carnality

Relationship is not the same thing as fellowship. Our salvation is based on our relationship to God. However, the level of our discipleship determines our fellowship with God.

A relationship with God begins the moment one receives salvation. However, fellowship with God is sustained through discipleship.

- 7B Paul instruct believers to no longer be children meaning its possible to remain immature/juvenile.
